Program

DAY 1 – THURSDAY APRIL 3	
<i>Meals included: dinner</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Naples</i>	
	Arrive on your own in Naples
2:00 pm	Check-in to MGallery Palazzo Caracciolo, our home for the next three nights
	This former monastery offers an oasis of peace in the middle of the bustling city of Naples and it is located steps away from all major attractions of the city
5:45 pm	Meet your fellow travelers for a short orientation talk, followed by a walk to a nearby historic pizza restaurant.
	On night 1, we toast to the beginning of the tour with a glass of wine and the original Neapolitan pizza
	Return to the hotel

DAY 2 - FRIDAY APRIL 4	
<i>Meals included: breakfast and food tasting (equal to lunch)</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Naples</i>	
	Breakfast is included
10:00 am	Board a private bus and transfer to the Spanish Quarter where we meet our local expert



	Embark on a food tour in one of the most lively neighborhoods of Naples, combining history with local culture and culinary tradition. Enjoy the freshest sardines, shrimps and calamari breaded and fried on the spot, served in the paper cone called " <i>cuoppo</i> ". Then we are off to a bakery for crunchy taralli, in a local restaurant for the pasta served with genovese sauce. We end in a local pastry for with stuffed puff pastry and espresso coffee.
1:30 pm	The food tour ends in the heart of the old town, where our tour managers can recommend a wide array of activities for a free afternoon. From the Veiled Christ (recommended booking it ahead), to a tour of the underground city, shopping or maybe a walk along the seafront for an iconic view of the bay of Naples.
	Return to the hotel on your own (inexpensive taxis available throughout the city).
	Dinner on your own - your tour managers can make reservations

DAY 3 - SATURDAY APRIL 5	
<i>Meals included: breakfast</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Naples</i>	
	Breakfast is included
9:00 am	Board a private bus and transfer to the harbor
9:45 am	Public ferry ride to Capri (about 1 hour)
10:45 am	Ride the funicular (cog wheel tram) from the marina up to the actual village of Capri
	After a short orientation walk, it's your choice to experience Capri at your own pace. We suggest following our tour managers along a 20-minute scenic walk to a panoramic spot overlooking the iconic rock formations known as "Faraglioni". Outdoor lovers can consider a hike up to the ruins of a Roman villa (1 hour each way, uphill), or simply enjoy lunch in one of the charming restaurants of the island, before riding the funicular back down.
3:45 pm	Public ferry back to Naples and private bus back to the hotel
	Dinner on your own - your tour managers can make reservations



DAY 4 - SUNDAY APRIL 6	
<i>Meals included: breakfast, and lunch</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Vietri sul Mare</i>	
	Breakfast and check out
9:30 am	Drive to Sant'Agata dei Goti (driving time 1h)
10:30 am	Take a stroll in this unique town built on top of a cliff, surrounded by two canyons
12:00 pm	Visit the underground cellars of MUSTILLI , an historic winery of the Sannio wine region
	Lunch (starter, first course and dessert) is served in the evocative underground rooms and is paired with a tasting of 3 wines from the winery's top labels "Selezioni" (Aglianico, Pedirosso, Greco)
3:00 pm	Drive to Vietri sul Mare
5:00 pm	Check-in at Lloyd's Baia Hotel in Vietri sul Mare
	Take a stroll with your tour managers along the seaside promenade
	Tonight dinner is on your own in one of the many restaurants and pizzeria available. Your tour managers can make reservations

DAY 5 - MONDAY APRIL 7	
<i>Meals included: breakfast, light lunch</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Vietri sul Mare</i>	
	Breakfast is included
10:30 am	Drive to Avellino wine region (1 hour)
11:45 am	Visit TENUTA CAVALIER PEPE , a wine producer focused on Fiano di Avellino. Take a walk in the vineyards of the estate and visit the cellar before reaching on foot their on-site restaurant
	A four-course lunch is paired with a vertical tasting of Fiano di Avellino DOCG, including two Riserva
2:30 pm	Short bus transfer to the town of Taurasi (5min)
3:00 pm	Visit SELLA DELLE SPINE winery. A tasting of 3 DOCG wines (Fiano, Greco di Tufo and Taurasi) paired with small food bites
5:00 pm	Depart for Salerno (1 hour)
6:00 pm	Arrive in Vietri sul Mare. Dinner on your own - your tour managers can make reservations



DAY 6 - TUESDAY APRIL 8	
<i>Meals included: breakfast, light lunch and afternoon brunch</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Sorrento</i>	
	Breakfast and check out
10:15 am	Drive to the southern Campania region (1h 40')
11:00 am	Visit a buffalo mozzarella farm (TENUTA VANNULO) and discover the secrets of \ ancient cheese production
11:45 am	Partake in a light lunch with a selection of mozzarella, fresh vegetables, local bread and buffalo milk gelato
1:00 pm	Relax as we transfer by bus to VIGNE DI RAITO , a small family-owned winery located on the highest slopes of the Amalfi Coast
2:00 pm	Take in the views of blue Mediterranean as we walk through a lemon grove that blooms twice a year and we reach the vineyard
	Wine tasting focused on the Amalfi DOC, paired with five small tastings of local products
4:30 pm	Drive to Sorrento (1h 30')
6:00 pm	Check-in to Hotel Michelangelo for the next three nights
	Optional orientation walk with the tour manager
	Dinner on your own in Sorrento - your tour managers can make reservations

DAY 7 - WEDNESDAY APRIL 9	
<i>Meals included: breakfast and lunch</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Sorrento</i>	
	Breakfast is included
9:30 am	Drive to the archeological site of Pompei (1 hour)
10:30 am	Meet our local expert guide and embark on a journey back in time as we discover a Roman city frozen in time.
12:30 pm	Transfer about 20 minutes to a winery located on the slopes of the volcano, on the edge of the Vesuvian National Park (SORRENTINO VINI)



	Lunch is served on a panoramic terrace overlooking the vineyards and the dark ash-like soil where local grape varieties such as Aglianico, Piediroso and Falanghina are grown
4:00 pm	Drive back to Sorrento (1 hour)
	Dinner on your own in Sorrento - your tour managers can make reservations

DAY 8 - THURSDAY APRIL 10	
<i>Meals included: breakfast, and dinner</i>	
<i>Accommodation: Sorrento</i>	
	Breakfast is included
9:00	Drive to the lower part of Positano with two or three separate vans (depending on size of the group) and enjoy breathtaking views of the coast
9:45	Stroll on the flights of steps that lead to the beach, exploring art galleries, boutique shops, and boutiques with the iconic white-linen fashion of the region
12:20	Board a public ferry from Positano to Amalfi
1:00	Free time for shopping among paper shops, souvenirs and lemon products. We recommend a stop in the pastry shop Pansa to indulge in one of the best "delizia al limone" of the Campania region, a sponge cake filled with lemon custard and dipped in lemon cream
3:30	Board a public ferry from Amalfi to Sorrento
5:00	Arrive to Sorrento and transfer with our private vans to the hotel
5:45	Free time
7:30	Farewell dinner in Sorrento, within a walking distance from the hotel
